

WHY it's important to not confuse specifics with details.

The preamble to all of this, however, is getting to the starting gate:

1. You need a goal lit up with hot desire FIRST.
2. Your WHY needs to be bigger than your excuses.
3. Despite the inconvenience or discomfort, you are willing to go there and put in the work.

There's a significant dynamic going on once you've launched your goal, fired it up with inspired action (watch the show from 1/7/2025 if you need more info), and that's being specific but not hung up on the details.

I shared a picture of my vision board.

Notice the dock in the top left corner?



That's not at all what my dock looks like, or the landscape, or the horizon, or even the beach...

None of it- those are DETAILS.

Specifically, this is a view from the house.

This helped me visualize -

All I needed, all my vision contained specifically was a house, on a lake, with a dock.

As for the details?

My house looks nothing like I expected it to.

My view is different (that's a detail!), but the specifics are on point! (House, lake, and a dock)

Once we get past our need for everything to be perfect (details), we can begin to get SPECIFIC (this is excellence!)

Love the Specifics, Leave the Details!
